


Jackson/Hinds Library System Branch Name Crossword Puzzle

- 2. A historic statue of its namesake is located on the grounds of this branch
- 3. This branch has a basement meeting room with a capacity of fifty people.
- 5. This branch is located at the Westside Community Center in Jackson
- 7. Opened on June 6, 2010, this branch, like many other branches, is named for a beloved local teacher.
- 8. Located in the heart of downtown Bolton, this branch was dedicated in 1990
- 10. The branch is named after an author, known for writing about race relations in the United States who became a French citizen in 1947
- 13. This branch is currently located behind City Hall in Byram

ACROSS

- 1. Located in the Golden Key Senior Center, this branch is named for one of the co-founders of the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party
- 4. Housed in an old a department store, this branch opened its doors in 1986
- 6. This branch is named for an author that appeared in Ken Burns's 1994 documentary Baseball
- 7. This branch is named for an acclaimed author that also taught at Jackson State University from 1949 to 1979
- 9. This branch is located behind the courthouse in the county seat of Hinds County
- 11. Named for "star teacher and counselor" that spent half of her 50 year career at Edwards Junior High School and the other half in Student Affairs at Tougaloo College
- 12. The walking trail at this branch is home to the "Walk of Honorees" honoring citizens that have accomplished great things.
