PUPRPOSE OF	Chairman Jones stated that the purpose of the meeting focused to bring Board members up to date about	
<b>MEETING:</b>	the Budget Hearing for the City of Jackson, library facilities and developments, and the FY 2021 audit.	
BUDGET HEARING	Chairman Jones confirmed the City of Jackson's Budget Hearing was scheduled for August 15, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. The budget proposal submitted for FY 22-23 was for \$1,947,008.00.

FACILITIES AND DEVELOPMENT UPDATES:	Mr. Council explained the leaky conditions at the Eudora Welty and Richard Wright Libraries, discussed the condition of the broken glass doors at Eudora Welty Library's front entrance, and talked about the plumbing and sewage issues and the usage of one bathroom for all patrons at the Bolden Moore Library. It was determined that Mr. Council write a letter to request that the Jackson Friends of the Library (JFOL) donate the repair of the broken glass doors at the front entrance of the Eudora Welty Library.	
	Motion: Dr. Earline Strickland, moved, seconded by Machelle Kyles to accept and approve the request of the JFOL to repair the broken glass at the front doors' entrance at the Eudora Welty Library.	
	Approval: There being neither objections nor abstentions, the motion carried.	
FY 2021 AUDIT UPDATE:	Chairman Jones provided FY 2021 audit updates and stated that the Jackson Friends of the Library (JFOL) is scheduled to discuss the existence of their book fund at the next Board Meeting on Tuesday, August 23, 2022.
